



DOG ETIQUETTE

We want to remain “Dog Friendly” but need your cooperation to do so. We do not allow cats.

- 2 dog maximum in cabin. \$20 per dog per day will be charged if additional dogs are discovered. This does not imply that extra dogs are permitted.
- 2 dog maximum in lodge. \$20 per dog per day will be charged if additional dogs are discovered. **Winter, only small dogs are permitted in lodge. We reserve the right to decline dogs in the lodge at our sole discretion.
- Camp Watanda Lodge is a licensed commercial kitchen, as such, dogs are **NOT ALLOWED** in the Lodge kitchen please use the gate to prevent their access to the kitchen and food prep area. Dogs are OK in the Cabin kitchen. Use gates as needed to contain animals.
- Please bring your dog’s own food and water bowl, do not use the camp dishes for this purpose.
- Please bring an extra towel for your dog to wipe off muddy paws and wet fur.
- Dogs cannot be left unattended in the Lodge or Cabin unless they are crated, nor can they roam free when you are away from the property. If you must leave the property without your dog, please crate them or find a suitable spot to tether them.
- Dogs are not allowed on the furniture, this includes the bed.
- Please clean-up “Puppy Poop” on common paths and play areas.
- Dogs must be up-to-date on rabies vaccinations.
- We recommend that you “pretreat” your dog with “Advantage” or similar topical flea and tick repellent 3 days prior to arrival. Fleas and ticks are rampant in this area and can cause fatal illness to humans and pets.
